House called of plaster & Pollux. An atrium or peristyle. Turn L into a court with colonnade on two sides - no entry to street wide place, a triclinium at E. end a bath or Piscina in court with a central col. for water. Here is the dwarf monkey, and round a Medea very fine countenance - has the sword in hand - two children on a sort of square block playing - each looking straight down at her - Here a door into the court or garden. Broad porticos - between pillars ~~crossed~~ a dove wall against the vicolo behind. Wall painted as garden with arches trees fountains, grass plots & piscina. an apollo against wall. a passage to vicolo from this garden or portico? ~~near~~ here. Scenes from plays painted. In Tablinum between garden & the great casedium on entry of this part of house. In an obscene chamber behind the shop of the Thermopolite opposite the house of the new fountain is a picture of a drinking party sitting round a table much in this manner. There were 2 small chambers to retire to. Did a Thermopolion in general imply this kind of house?? This is opposite a street a house of a Modestus.



#### In house of new Fountain

This house has like that of the first fountain a court with a broad portico. & <sup>not</sup> a pseudo garden on the wall. The wall painted with the picture of beggar & child on R. Black panels under portico R. on L of front picture with the man & hat  - on R lateral wall landscape with moles ports & porticos in the water - 2 small chambers on R of R lateral portico. in one this ornament near ground. R of Tablinum between atrium & inner portico a room with bricks painted. Game. chases &c. The fountain has shells  & so as well as the others -

In the house of the Dioceci, the two chests for money do not seem to have touched the wall where the painting continues, but to have been 2 or 3 inches off.
